



Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) 2005 Disaster Recovery Initiative (DRI) Supplemental Grant

The U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development provided funding from the 2005 Supplemental Community Development Block Grant Disaster Recovery Initiative to the Florida Department of Community Affairs which provided funding to the Broward County Board of County Commissioners. The Broward County Board of County Commissioners and the City of Sunrise, Florida executed an Agreement in the amount of \$1,979,161 for Service Area 24-Citywide Multi Family and Single Family Rehabilitation and Hardening.

Assistance in accordance with the requirements of the Florida DCA Contract Number 08-DB-D3-11-16-01-A06 and the Broward County Agreement is available in the following programs and will be distributed to eligible applicants who own and occupy the dwelling as a primary residence.

The CDBG funds will be directed to:

- Wind mitigation improvements including storm shutters, windows, doors, and roof replacement including wind mitigation enhancements in compliance with the Florida Building Code.
- Building Code Compliance, Housing Quality Standards, and Health and Safety needs.

Applying for Assistance and Public Comment
